



Volunteers Needed for Modern Pentathlon
Ambassador Program Looking To Increase Volunteer Base

POMONA, CA (Jan. 2, 2017) - Fairplex is looking for dependable and energetic volunteers to help at the 2017 Modern Pentathlon World Cup, which will be hosted at Fairplex Feb. 22-26.

Volunteers assist in a number of positions and areas throughout the magnum five-day event. Whether it is a half shift or a full shift, volunteers will be scheduled based on their availability. In addition to serving as greeters and directional guides, volunteers will assist event organizers in one of the following areas:

- Course/Range attendants will work with referees on monitoring a course or timing an athlete during the sporting activities. Events include: 200M Freestyle Swim, Fencing, Equestrian Show Jumping, 3000M Run and Laser Pistol Shooting.
- General volunteers will be assigned to one of the following "General" staffing roles: ID security check, media escort, floater, runner, and volunteer sign-in, among others.
- Field Trip volunteers will greet buses, guide students to exhibitions, monitor classes and be general field trip attendants.
- Venue Set up/Breakdown volunteers will help set-up and/or break-down sports equipment, tents, tables and chairs at the various sports and special function venues.
- Hospitality volunteers will act as Ambassadors for the community to welcome all athletes, visitors and spectators to the various sports and special events venues. Volunteers may be tasked with greeting arriving athletes and guests at the airport, as well as assisting in ushering athletes from one sporting location to the next.

Individuals who have a background in any of the sports mentioned above are encouraged to join the volunteer ranks and help at this world-renowned event.

The Ambassador Volunteer Program consists of dedicated volunteers, called Ambassadors, willing to share their time, talents and commitment to serving others through various activities.
