Fairplex Sheraton – Necessary Asset for COVID-19 Pandemic

To Whom This May Concern:

I am writing to express my support regarding Los Angeles County's short-term lease of the Fairplex Sheraton to respond to the COVID-19 (or Novel Coronavirus) pandemic. COVID-19 has changed life as we know it and, with use of the Pomona Fairplex as a quarantine site, we will be able to return to our lives safely in a timelier fashion.

The San Gabriel Valley Civic Alliance was founded in 2010. Our mission is to bring together a diverse coalition of stakeholders from the Business, Labor, Government, Education and Community sectors for the purpose of identifying policy challenges and best practice solutions that transcend the traditional industry methods/modes of thinking. The SGVCA has seen Pomona and the surrounding communities always step up for its communities. We know that they will meet this moment through the opportunity to use the Fairplex to tackle the many challenges resulting from COVID-19.

By providing accommodations to our friends, families, and neighbors, the Fairplex will be a safe space to isolate and heal.
