



### **Capstone Art Exhibit To Celebrate Art From The Students Of The Millard Sheets Art Center**

POMONA, CA (April 6, 2016) - The Millard Sheets Art Center at Fairplex is pleased to present its third annual Capstone Art Exhibition showcasing dozens of art submissions from students enrolled in the art center's classes. This year, over 50 art pieces are expected to be displayed in the gallery. Exhibition will feature paintings, drawings and ceramics.

Though a few classes have a cost, the majority of them, such as the ones offered by the Career and Technical Education Center – a program of The Learning Centers at Fairplex – are free of charge to students in subjects that may not be available at their schools.

The classes of the Millard Sheets Art Center focus on the creation, research, exhibition and the communication of fine art and design. Curricula are designed to prepare students for continued study and work in college or in the workplace. Students explore concepts and build skills that can be applied to contemporary art practice in any field.

In addition to featuring the work of current students, we will also be exhibiting work from the talented alumni who have gone on to study and/or work in the creative fields of art and design.

The public is invited to an opening reception from 5-7 p.m. Thursday, April 28. A graduation ceremony will also take place during this time for high school seniors who have been part of any art program for two or more semesters. Regular exhibition hours are Saturdays, noon-4 p.m. The exhibition is free to attend. Parking is at Gate 1 on McKinley Ave.
