Pomona, CA (July 2, 2019) – Fairplex presents KABOOM!, a Fourth of July fireworks spectacular at the historic Grandstands! This is the 34th annual Independence Day celebration Fairplex has hosted with each year growing bigger and better.

Metal Mulisa, Fitz Army Freestyle Motorcross, Quad Wars and monster trucks will take to the dirt for a high flying motor cross show before the firework show from 8 – 9 p.m.

Firework enthusiasts can show up early to hit the Pit Party beginning at 5 p.m. where they can find great photo ops with Monster Truck drivers, take a ride on a Monster Truck and buy some motorsports memorabilia to remember the day by!

The show will open with the National Anthem being sung by the winner of the Oh Say Can You Sing online singing contest.
