This February, LA County is transitioning from polling places to vote centers. This new model will allow LA County residents to cast a ballot at any vote center location in the County over an 11-day period. Fairplex will be hosting the largest voting center in the eastern San Gabriel Valley from February 22 – March 3. The Voting Center will be located in Club One, under the Grandstand in the center of our campus, with voters entering the grounds through Gate 1. Hours will be 8 AM to 5 PM with extended hours on March 3, 7 AM to 8 PM.

Fairplex is honored to be hosting a Vote Center. To thank you for doing your civic duty, we invite you to join us for a cup of coffee on us after casting your ballot.
