Highlights of all the Fair fun!

- LA County Fair **Parades** are held **every Friday at 5 p.m.** Don't miss the participants and the Budweiser Clydesdales as they make their way around the Fair. The Clydesdales also parade up and down Broadway every day at noon.
- Play Your Way Stage will host **Bob Baker Marionette Theater** in residence each day of the Fair. And don't miss fun **Fair contests** in between like hula hooping, bubble gum blowing and other themed contests like Mother-Daughter Look-A-Like on Mother's Day.
- Enter the **Bloomiverse** of large-scale floral and art installations as the **Flower & Garden Pavilion** will transform into — an immersive floral world where color, motion and imagination converge.
- **RailGiants Train Museum** is **celebrating its 70th anniversary**. The museum is home to some of the country's most well-preserved locomotives, rail cars and a caboose.
- Ray Cammack Shows returns for its 40th year as the official **fun zone** of Fair.
- Back for its final year, **Skate-R-Cade returns**, encouraging guests of all ages to play their way with wheels and arcade games.
- **Clay Play** at the Millard Sheets Art Center will be back to introduce this art form to a diverse range of patrons of all ages who may not have previously had the opportunity to experience for a nominal fee.

Also in the **Millard Sheets Art Center**, **Claremont Temporary** gathers regional contemporary artists to **present Play Pavillion: A Survey of Regional Creative Subcultures**.

Food Drive Thursdays: May 14, 21 and 28. Bring 5 cans of food (per person) for free entry that day from 11 AM- 4PM. Donated food will be distributed to local food pantries.
