



**LA County Fair Opens Registration for FairKids Field Trip Program
Hands-On Learning Meets Fair Fun for K-6 Students During May Field Trips at
Fairplex**

Registration is now open for the FairKids Field Trip Program at the LA County Fair, giving teachers, principals and homeschool educators an opportunity to bring K-6 students to Fairplex for an interactive day of learning, exploration and fun.

Designed to bring classroom lessons to life, FairKids Field Trips offer students an educational experience the Fair describes as *"A Day of Learning Cleverly Disguised as Fun!"* Students can explore exhibits, discover history, connect with nature and agriculture, and experience art and culture throughout the Fairgrounds.

Field trips are scheduled for 9 to 11 a.m. on May 7, 13 and 21. Schools are welcome to remain at the Fair after 11 a.m., when the Fair opens to the public.

Students and teachers can explore educational attractions including:

- Rail Giants Historical Trains – Step into history and explore the evolution of rail transportation.
- The Farm at Fairplex – Discover agriculture and where food comes from through hands-on experiences.
- America's Great Outdoors – Learn about the natural world and the great outdoors.
- The Big Red Barn – Get up close with farm life and animals.
- Millard Sheets Art Center – Experience art and creativity in a unique cultural setting.

- Flower & Garden – Explore plants, gardens and the beauty of the natural world.

The Fair will also host Fair Stars on Thursday, May 27, from 9 to 11 a.m., providing an inclusive Fair experience specifically designed for students with special needs, disabilities and neurodivergencies. During Fair Stars, students and their families can enjoy the Fair in a more welcoming environment, with reduced noise, fewer crowds and limited flashing lights.

FairKids Field Trip tickets are \$2 for students and \$6 for chaperones, making the program an affordable way to supplement classroom learning with an engaging, real-world experience.

Teachers and school administrators are encouraged to plan ahead and reserve their field trip date early.
