## **NOTICE** Training Exercise

On **Dec. 8** Fairplex will be conducting a training exercise. The training will be held in conjunction with the Pomona Police Department and the Los Angeles County Fire Department.

The primary areas of the exercise will be inside the Fairplex campus, near the administration buildings located at Gate 1 off McKinley Avenue. Law enforcement and first responder vehicles will be seen entering and exiting the Fairplex grounds. There will be signs near the entry into Gate 1 informing the public that a training exercise is underway; we ask that any business at Fairplex be postponed until the following day. A small amount of noise will occur briefly at the beginning of the exercise however, we do not anticipate the noise having an impact outside of the immediate Fairplex grounds.

This type of training exercise helps improve the state of readiness and responsiveness for Fairplex staff and local first responder agencies. We appreciate your understanding and ask that all members of the public avoid gathering to watch this training drill to allow the first responders to focus on this learning exercise.
