



Frequently Asked Questions

- What is happening at KABOOM! this year?
KABOOM!, is Fairplex's annual heart-pounding, patriotic tribute to America featuring a riveting display of fireworks, motocross and monster trucks. Enjoy entertainment at the Red, White & Blue Stage. New this year: Tuff Truck races, where street legal and modified trucks, race the clock for the best time.
- How do I get tickets?
Admission tickets and parking can be purchased online at fairplex.com/kaboom.
- What does a ticket include?
Your admission ticket includes entry to see monster trucks, motocross, Tuff Trucks, entertainment with 80's All-Stars on stage and the fireworks show.
- Is food available?
Food stands will be open serving food, beverages and treats. See a complete list of offerings at fairplex.com/kaboom.
- Where do I park?
General parking is available at Gate 17 with prevailing rates. Uber, Lyft, and Taxi drop-off/pick-up is available at Gate 1 on McKinley Ave
- How much are tickets?
Buy online: General Admission Seat: \$22; Box Seat: \$35
Purchase at the gate (on July 4): General Admission Seat: \$30; Box Seat: \$40
*Children under age 2 do not need a ticket if they sit on a paying guest's lap during the entire show.
- What are the hours?
Doors open at 4 p.m.; fireworks start at 9:15 p.m.
- Is cash accepted?
Admission, parking and alcohol sales are all card only. Some food stands may accept cash.
- Can I bring my own food?

- Can I tailgate?
Tailgating is not allowed, nor are personal lawn or beach chairs. Personal grills are also not allowed.
