This year's FairKids program at the LA County Fair was a great success, drawing in an impressive 19,000 participants over four days. What makes this achievement even more exciting is that 42% of these students were first-time attendees, highlighting the program's expanding reach and impact.

FairKids offers student, parents and teachers an enjoyable, interactive, educational experience, or



as we like to call it, A Day Full of Learning Cleverly Disguised as Fun! Participants from across Southern California eagerly made the trip to Pomona, with some driving up to 115 miles to take part in this enriching field trip. The excitement was contagious[®] as young learners immersed themselves in interactive exhibits and hands-on activities that brought lessons to life in a variety of subjects including art, science, agriculture, and history.

This year also saw a significant increase in partner participation, further enhancing the educational experience. The San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control, Xerces Society, WeCompost2, Lucas Museum of Narrative Art, LACMA, California Botanic Garden, The Culture of the Low and Slow, and the Los Angeles County Natural History Museum all contributed to engaging and informative sessions. Of the 19,000 FairKids participants, 1,500 participated in FairStars enjoying the Fair and carnival rides in a quieter environment without the usual lights and sounds to create greater access for guests with auditory processing and neurodivergent needs. After witnessing the success of our FairStars program in the past, we realized that a quieter atmosphere could benefit even more guests. While we've previously offered a field trip version of Thoughtful Thursday, this year marked the first time we extended it to the Fair's open



hours. With minimal sound and lighting, visitors could fully enjoy everything the LA County Fair has to offer in a more comfortable setting.


CHEERS AT THE FARM
