Best of Class: An outstanding Gold Medal spirit that is superior in its class and scored 94 points or higher

Gold Medal: An outstanding spirit of superior character and style

Silver Medal: A very good spirit with special qualities

Bronze Medal: A well-made spirit

Best of Show: This award is presented to the Best Mixer of the Spirits Competition
