Los Angeles International Wine Competition Judging March 25, 26, & 27, 2026 Mrs. Spreti Valente, Wine Chairwomen

The Los Angeles International Wine Competition and its panel of esteem judges invite you to participate in the 91st anniversary competition.

1. **ENTRY FEE** <sup>(1)</sup> – Early Bird - \$90 per entry received before January 5, 2026, \$115 per entry beginning January 6, 2025. Payment may be made by credit card: Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover, by U.S. check payable to: "Los Angeles County Fair Association", or by wire transfer. Please email a copy of the wire transfer to the Competitions office at <a href="mailto:competitions.com">competitions.com</a>. Entry fee must accompany entry form to be eligible for competition.

 SHIPPING – International wines will be accepted through March 6, 2026. Shipments are received on weekdays from 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. All wines entered MUST BE SHIPPED PREPAID. The competition is not responsible for any customs or shipping charges.

## All SPIRITS BOTTLES: Must have a label affixed to the back of the bottle that contains the US Government Warning and carry a statement these bottles are "TRADE SAMPLES – Not for Resale

The statement reads as follows and should be 2mm to 3mm in size.

**GOVERNMENT WARNING:** (1) ACCORDING TO THE SURGEON GENERAL, WOMEN SHOULD NOT DRINK ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES DURING PREGNANCY BECAUSE OF THE RISK OF BIRTH DEFECTS. (2) CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IMPAIRS OUR ABILITY TO DRIVE A CAR OR OPERATE MACHINERY, AND MAY CAUSE HEALTH PROBLEMS.

- 3. **ENTRIES** <sup>(2)</sup> An entry shall consist of at least three (6) bottles. PLEASE LIST CLASS/CATEGORY NUMBERS ON ENTRY FORM. Entries are assigned random judging codes and then placed on storage racks in our cellar separated into categories. All deliveries should be received by the shipping deadline (March 6), allowing ample time for wines to recover from transportation bottle shock before being judged. Before judging, servers place codes on the tasting glasses, and the wines are carefully poured into the proper glasses. The coded tasting glasses are then placed in front of each judge. Each judge tastes the wine and makes selections independently.
- 4. **Judging**: The Los Angeles International Wine Competition uses a 100-point scoring system based on Appearance, Aroma, Taste, and Finish.
  - The decision of the judges is final, and no changes will be made to awards after the judging is complete.
- 5. Awards and Medals: We award Gold, Silver, Bronze Best of Class, Best of Division and Best of Show. An award or medal is given to a producer for a particular wine produced. Best of Class awards will be awarded by division, category. Best of Class wines will compete for Best of Division. Best of Division wines will compete for the "Don Galleano Award" in honor of Don Galleano. The Los Angeles International Wine Competition will offer, for purchase, Best of Show, Best of Division, Best of Class, Gold, Silver, and Bronze award seals to the producers that won these awards.
- 6. Results: April 6, 2026, the competition results will be posted on the website www.LAWineComp.com.
- 7. May 7 31, 2026 is the Los Angeles County Fair. All International Competition award-winning products will be displayed in the Tasting Room. There will also be gold medal wine and olive oil tastings, and education seminars featuring entrants from Olive Oil, Wine, Spirits and Dairy competitions in the Tasting Room education classroom.
