AWARDS OFFERED PER CATEGORY

Best of Class: 94 – 100 pts: An outstanding Gold Medal wine that is superior in its class

Gold Medal: 90 – 100 pts: An outstanding wine of superior character and style

Silver Medal: A very good wine with special qualities

Bronze Medal: A well-made wine
