The highest recognition a wine can receive, awarded to the "Best of the Best" and selected from the Best of Class Award Winners only.

AWARDS OFFERED PER CATEGORY

Best of Class: 94 – 100 pts: An outstanding Gold Medal wine that is superior in its class Gold Medal: 90 – 100 pts: An outstanding wine of superior character and style Silver Medal: A very good wine with special qualities

Bronze Medal: A well-made wine

Please note this is an additional competition, and wine may enter both the Limited Production and Traditional Competitions.
